## Norma Miller Essay Competition

**Value: Three prizes-- \$200 each**

The three prizes are awarded annually for the best essay in each of three competitions:

**1. Norma Miller Prize in AHCL 2300Y :**

**Eligibility:** The prize is awarded to the essay judged the best in competition from the students in *AHCL 2300Y*, Introduction to Classical Literature. Students may enter one essay already submitted in the course, or a new essay written for the competition.

**2. Roman History:**

**Eligibility:** The prize is awarded to the essay judged the best in competition from students enrolled in *AHCL 2100Y*, *AHCL 2200Y*, or *AHCL 2320H*. Students may enter one essay (must be on a Roman topic) already submitted in any of these courses, or a new essay written for the competition.

**3. 4000-level:**

**Eligibility:** The prize is awarded to the essay judged best in competition. Open to students enrolled in a 4000-level course within the Department. Students may enter one essay in the competition.

**DEADLINE: April 25, 2011 by 4pm**

**All submissions** should be either hand delivered to the AH & Classics Office (CC G15) or sent electronically to [kaxcell@trentu.ca](mailto:kaxcell@trentu.ca) from the student's Trent email account. Submissions should have an anonymous cover page attached to the essay indicating the title of the essay and which Norma Miller essay competition (i.e., *AHCL 2300Y*, Roman History or 4000-level) entering **ONLY**; and submit a separate cover sheet with title of essay, competition and student's name and number, so that the essay may be judged fairly.
