Course Description:

Students must successfully complete BIOL 4460H that consists of a placement in a hospital setting for the equivalent of three hours a week for 12 weeks. Students will also be assigned practical readings and background theory every week from their preceptor. BIOL 4460H is open to students who have earned at least 13.5 university credits and achieved a cumulative average of at least 80%. Prerequisite: BIOL 3830H, 3840H. Co-requisites: BIOL 4160H & 4320H. Enrolment is limited and competitive. Application forms can be obtained from the Biology office. Students may not apply retroactively. Excludes BIOL4450Y.
