

Criteria for Membership in a Graduate Program:

Master's Supervisory / Graduate Teaching Membership

- Nomination by program
- Ph.D. or equivalent qualification appropriate to the discipline
- An established program of research, including peer-reviewed publications and/or other evidence of productivity in scholarship, research and creative activity, appropriate to the discipline
- Evidence of external or internal research funds, as appropriate to the discipline

Doctoral Supervisory Membership

In addition to criteria for Master's Supervisory membership:

- A successful record of participation in graduate education (such as teaching a graduate course, serving on a supervisory committee, or examination committee), where such participation is possible
