Policy on timeline for Canadian Studies PhD candidates to undertake the teaching of courses:

In an effort to ensure timely completion, the Frost Centre strongly suggests that Canadian Studies PhD candidates not undertake the role of course instructor at Trent or elsewhere until they have:

- Completed their comprehensive exams
- Successfully defended their proposal
- Accomplished a significant portion of their dissertation research and/or demonstrated equivalent progress in the writing of their dissertation.

PhD candidates are strongly encouraged to talk with their supervisor and the Director before applying for any teaching positions at Trent or elsewhere, even if they have met these benchmarks.
