## BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF DUTIES:

Presentation and preparation of EDUC 4662Y which will investigate theories of instructional practice supporting student learning in Chemistry. The foundational concepts of chemical science will be linked to contemporary theories of assessment and evaluation of pupil performance to develop effective teaching and learning models. Duties include delivery of all classes, the preparation and marking of assignments, the development of tests and examinations, submission of grades, as required and the maintenance of reasonable hours for student contact outside of scheduled hours.
