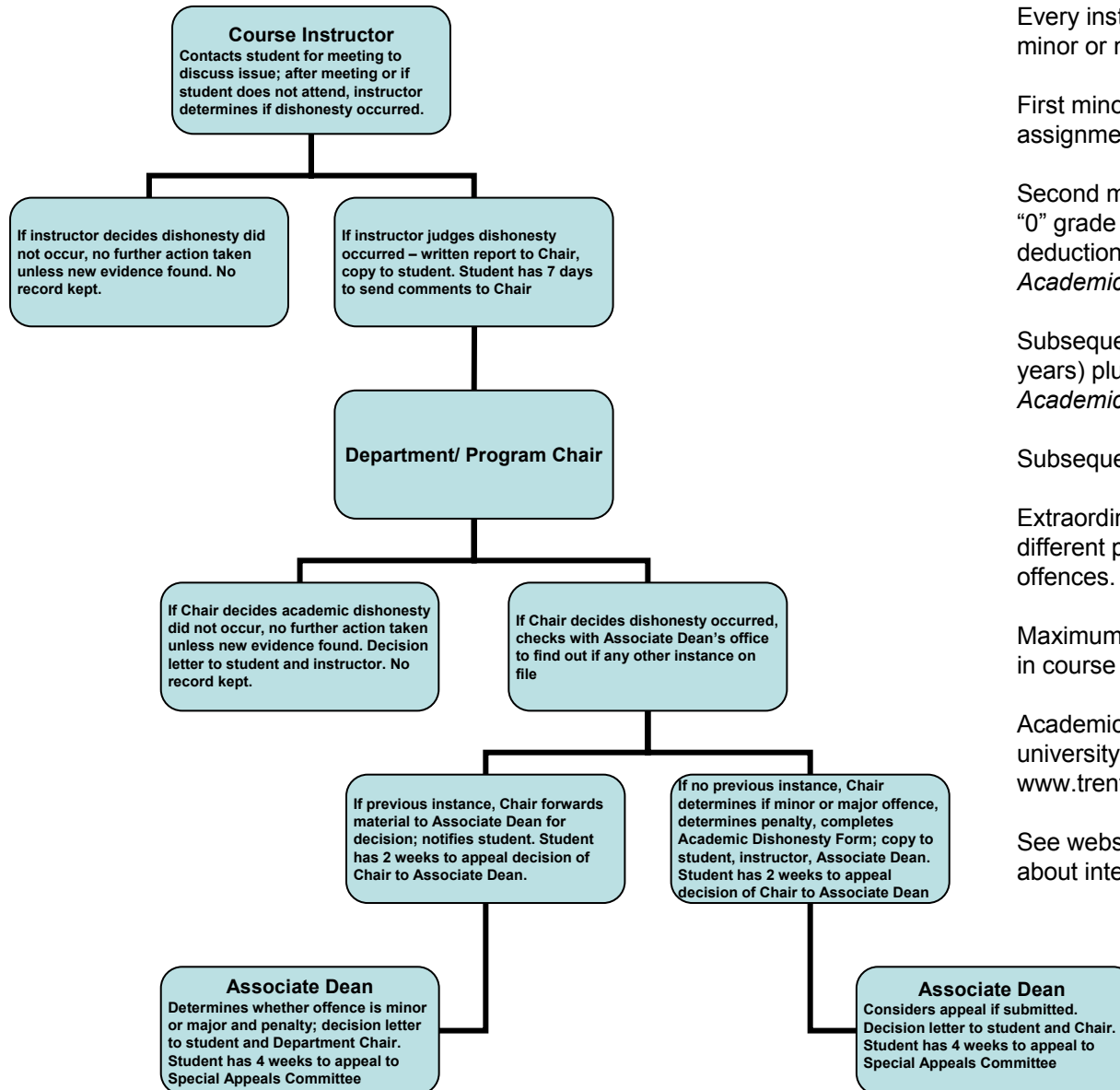


Undergraduate Academic Integrity Policy Procedure at a glance...



Every instance of dishonesty is classified as minor or major .

First minor offence: penalty of “0” grade on assignment/test and no option to re-write.

Second minor or first major offence: penalty of “0” grade and no option to re-write plus marks deduction in course plus transcript notation of *Academic Dishonesty*

Subsequent offence: Suspension (1 term – 2 years) plus transcript notation: *Suspension – Academic Dishonesty*

Subsequent offence: expulsion from university

Extraordinary circumstances may justify different penalties for above categories of offences.

Maximum penalty Chair can impose: “0” grade in course plus transcript notation
