



THE P.K. Page Irwin PRIZE

Created in honour of P. K. Page Irwin's extraordinary achievement in the arts, the P. K. Page Irwin Prize is awarded to a student who has shown special merit in creative writing and at least one of the other arts.

The P. K. Page Irwin Prize is open to all Trent University students who are registered in at least one course in the current academic year. Submissions should consist of a literary manuscript (fiction, poetry, drama or creative non-fiction) and a portfolio representing the applicant's work in one of the other arts. The manuscript should be no more than 20 pages in length. The portfolio should consist of representative samples of the applicant's work in the form of photographs, CDs, DVDs, etc. Material in the submission should not previously have been published.

Submissions should be made to the English Department office, 134 Wallis Hall, Traill College, by 4:00 PM Monday, April 25, 2011. Applicants should provide a cover page with their name and summer address but should not identify themselves on the manuscript or other material submitted.

Submissions will be adjudicated by a committee of four, three from the University and one from the Peterborough arts community. Announcement of the winner will be made on the English Department website. The value of the Prize for 2010-2011 is \$500.
