

**Personal Vehicle Driving Directions
To the Environmental and Resource Studies Program, Trent University
from North Bay area (from the north)**

1. Take highway 11 south out of North Bay down to highway 60 turnoff (at Huntsville).
2. Take highway 60 east to highway 35 (at Lake of Bays).
3. Travel highway 35 south to highway 121 (just south of Minden).
4. Travel highway 121 south to highway 49.
5. Travel highway 49 south to highway 36 (at Bobcaygeon).
6. Travel highway 36 east to highway 23 (at Buckhorn).
7. Travel highway 23 (also called Buckhorn Road) south to highway 29 (also called Lakefield Rd.); turn right (continuing south).
8. Travel highway 29 south to Nassau Mills Rd (also called River Road or highway 32) (this intersection is the first light you encounter on highway 29). Turn left.
9. Travel past the Trent University main entrance, over the Otonabee River, and over the canal, turning right at East Bank Drive (first right after the footbridge crossing the river).
10. Park in the first parking lot on the left ("Blue" lot, where visitors can park- pay and display).
11. Walk through the staff

parking lot to the Environmental Science Centre (building closest to the Otonabee river; the building is signed at the turning circle entrance), and take the outside stairs from the turning circle up to the second floor and enter the building.

12. Turn right and go through a set of doors; the Environmental and Resource Studies Program office is the first door on the left hand side (2nd floor), room ESC B202.
