

OSAP Eligibility Summer 2017

Full-Time:

Students enrolled in at least 1.5 credits (at least 60% of a full course load), and students with a permanent disability enrolled in at least 1.0 credits (at least 40% of a full course load), between April 27, 2017 and July 31, 2017 with a break in studies of no more than 4 weeks will be considered full-time for the purposes of OSAP funding. Students enrolled in 1.0 credits during a 6 week period are considered full-time for the purposes of OSAP for that period of time.

By adding full-time Summer OSAP you are agreeing to pass a minimum of 1.5 credits during the Summer term. Course load changes may cause a change to your OSAP eligibility so students are encouraged to contact the Financial Aid office before making any changes to your course load.

Students with a 2016-2017 OSAP Assessment

Fill-out the OSAP extension form and submit it to the Financial Aid office to add the Summer to your existing 2016-2017 OSAP assessment. Part-Time:

Students that do not meet the criteria above may be eligible for part-time funding for studies in Summer 2017. Students taking less than 1.0 credits must be enrolled in a course that is at least 4 weeks long.

Ontario Student Opportunity Grant (OSOG)

The Ontario Student Opportunity Grant (OSOG) is available to help students reduce their annual Canada-Ontario Integrated Student Loan (COISL) debt. If you are eligible for OSOG, your grant will be applied directly to your outstanding COISL debt. Your actual grant is not awarded until at least 60 days after your latest study period end date for the academic year.
