

## Intellectual Property – Confidentiality and data release

In the case of faculty involved in IP commercialization, the Creator(s) will be free to present the results of research involved in IP development at conferences and other meetings, and/or publish in journals, books and other media. If the proposed presentation or publication contains IP, the Creator(s) shall submit the text to the other parties involved in commercialization at least 1 month in advance of the presentation or submission date. Within 5 working days of the receipt of this material, these parties will meet with the Creator(s) to discuss the necessity of delaying the presentation or publication in order to file a patent application. In this case, with the consent of the creator(s) and subject to policies at the institution(s), the Creator(s) shall withhold the text from presentation or from submission for publication for a period of up to 60 days, after which the Creator(s) shall be free to present or publish. These terms shall also apply to graduate student theses.
