- You are a resident of Ontario and are originally from a rural community outside of the Greater Toronto Area.
- You are a first-generation university student (first in your family to attend university).
- You are eligible for the Ontario Student Assistance Program (OSAP) and will complete your OSAP application and submit the required paperwork by July 31 2026.
- You will be a returning full-time student with a cumulative GPA of 80% or higher.
