PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Supervise a group of campers and ensure their health and safety
- Support camper engagement, safety, belonging and inclusion of children with exceptionalities and specific needs.
- Inclusion staff support children with various developmental, cognitive and behavioral needs to successfully integrate into our Summer Camp programs.
- Counselors roles is to promote and support the wellbeing of children and youth, including their cognitive, emotional, physical and social needs.
- Integrate new initiatives and activities as needed
- Foster a positive team dynamic within the counsellor group





- Manage group dynamics and individual campers' behaviour to ensure a positive and safe environment for all
- Bring a positive and energetic attitude to camp each day with a focus on inclusivity
- Other duties as assigned by the Youth Development Coordinator (may include regular administrative tasks)

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- Must be 18 years of age or older to apply
- Experience supporting children and youth with cognitive, physical and/or behavioral needs
- Experience supporting children and youth with self regulation strategies is an asset
- Strong leadership and judgement skills
- Excellent customer service knowledge and experience
- Experience working with children and youth, preferably in a camp setting
- First Aid/CPR and AED
- Police Record Check with Vulnerable Sector Screening
- Behavior Management Systems, Non-Violent Crisis Intervention (or an approved equivalent) would be a strong asset.
- Additional qualifications (ECE, EA, Child and Youth Diploma) an asset
