# **ABOUT THE POSITION:**

Working as a Lifeguard/Instructor with Trent Athletics provides you with an opportunity to learn and develop skills that you can take forward to future employment.

## Responsibilities:

- Ensure that Trent students and community members receive an outstanding customer service experience by providing a friendly and welcoming environment. This includes proactively greeting every individual and maintaining knowledge of programs, services, and processes.
- Maintain a safe aquatic environment at all times, educating participants regarding safe swimming habits, upholding pool and facility safety standards for all individuals using the facilities.





- Maintain the aesthetic quality of the Athletics Centre and ensure the pool deck is clean and free
  of clutter at all times; keep guard office neat and clean; perform washroom and change room
  checks and do spot cleaning as needed. Clean and sanitize exercise equipment and associated
  touchpoints. Use cleaning and sanitizing materials in accordance with University health and
  safety policies.
- Conduct pool tests and record results according to departmental protocol, and communicate abnormal results with supervisors. Maintain a log of daily pool procedures.
- Initiate emergency procedures and respond to situations requiring first aid within the Aquatics Centre and facility as a whole. Write incident reports when required.
- Deliver high quality swim lessons by planning, organizing, and teaching class outlines, based on Lifesaving Society standards. Completes and submits records and documentation of completed classes and writes progress reports for lessons
- Adapt teaching approach to match the experience and abilities of participants and regularly communicate with parents regarding their child's progress.
- Follow up on student/member questions to ensure that issues are resolved in a timely and professional manner.
- Review and perform daily on-shift task checklist and proactively carry out those tasks.
- Help organize and assist in the development of special programs, activities or instruction.
- Share innovative ideas and suggestions to help improve team performance.
- Stay informed about new information regarding the pool/pool programs/training sessions, ensure qualifications remain up-to-date.
- Comply with all Trent University and Athletics & Recreation Department policies and processes (including dress code) and participate in all mandatory training (mandatory monthly in-services, etc.)

# Minimum Skills & Qualifications:

- Priority consideration may be given to Trent students receiving OSAP and who are eligible for the Trent Work Study Program, however, any qualified person is encouraged to apply.
- Current National Lifeguard Service Award (NLS) required
- Current Lifesaving Society Swim Instructors Awards required
- Current Standard First Aid and CPR C certification required
- Lifeguarding and instructing experience considered an asset
- Further certifications (Instructors, Examiners, etc.) considered an asset
- High level of responsibility and professionalism
- Exceptional communication and customer service skills/experience
- Ability to adapt and problem-solve on a daily basis
- Flexible schedule (includes early mornings, days, evenings and weekends)
