ABOUT THE POSITION:

Reporting to the Athletic Therapist & Wellness Coordinator and working in conjunction with Athletics Game Day staff, provide on-field game coverage for the Trent University Varsity teams, for both home and away games.

Responsibilities:

- Provide assessment of acute injuries, on-field emergency medical care, prophylactic taping, sideline concussion assessment, etc.
- Record student-athletes' injuries in Player's Health and update their playing status.
- Managing student-athlete return to activity in a safe manner.
- Communicate with coaching staff in a timely and effective manner.
- Review Emergency Action Plan with game day staff, coaches, and opposition team medical personnel.
- Be up to date with industry leading information, techniques, and developments in the area of athletic therapy/physiotherapy and health and wellness.
- Promote a positive professional image of the Excalibur program by providing high quality customer service to all student-athletes.





Qualifications:

- Certified athletic therapist, physiotherapist, or other regulated healthcare profession in good standing with the CATA, CPO, or applicable regulatory body.
- Valid First Responder, BLS, or First Aid & CPR certificate.
- Strong organizational and communication skills.
- Demonstrated ability to work as a team player.
