Your role will be integral to creating an immersive experience for online spectators, ensuring all technical aspects of the broadcast are managed with precision. If you are passionate about sports, technology, and providing an engaging experience for fans, this role offers a unique opportunity to contribute to the promotion of Trent University's athletic events.



Responsibilities:

- Assist with set up and operation of the live stream broadcast for Trent University Excalibur events, ensuring smooth execution from setup to completion.
- Set up and manage live streaming equipment, including cameras, audio systems, and production software, to deliver a high-quality broadcast.
- Coordinate with the production team to ensure seamless integration of camera angles, graphics, and live feeds, enhancing the viewer experience.
- Collaborate with other event staff assisting with technical operations, ensuring effective collaboration and smooth event execution.
- Troubleshoot and resolve any technical issues that arise during the live stream to prevent interruptions.
- Work closely with the commentary team to ensure synchronization of visuals and commentary for a cohesive online viewing experience.
- Maintain, update, and troubleshoot streaming equipment, ensuring uninterrupted broadcasts.
- Stay informed on the latest live streaming trends and technologies, continuously improving the quality of the broadcasts.

Qualifications:

- Knowledge of live streaming equipment, production software, and broadcasting technology is an asset.
- Previous experience in live event broadcasting, including managing and operating live stream equipment, preferred.
- Strong organizational skills, with the ability to manage multiple technical aspects of a live stream broadcast simultaneously.
