Responsibilities:

- Provide dynamic and engaging live stream commentary for Trent University varsity athletic events, including pregame, in-game, and post-game commentary for sports such as Soccer, Rugby, Field Lacrosse, and Volleyball.
- Conduct research on teams, players, and relevant statistics to ensure accurate and insightful commentary during broadcasts.
- Make clear and concise virtual announcements, including player introductions, score updates, and other relevant information to enhance the online fan experience.
- Work closely with the production team to coordinate timing, camera angles, and other technical aspects to ensure a seamless and professional live stream.
- Demonstrate flexibility in adapting commentary style based on the sport and virtual audience, ensuring an enjoyable experience for online viewers.
- Collaborate effectively with fellow commentators, production staff, and university officials to maintain a cohesive and professional online broadcast.
- Stay informed on industry trends and best practices in live stream commentary to continuously improve the quality of broadcasts.

Qualifications:

- Priority will be given to Trent students.
- Availability to work weekend shifts and flexible hours during game days.
- Knowledge of specific sports, rules, and strategies, particularly those relevant to Trent University's varsity athletic programs, is preferred.
- Excellent verbal communication skills with the ability to articulate thoughts clearly, concisely, and energetically in an online setting.
- Strong research abilities to gather and synthesize information quickly, ensuring well-prepared and informed live commentary.
- Collaborative mindset and the ability to work effectively within a team, including broadcasting staff, event staff, and fellow live stream commentators.
- Familiarity with live streaming equipment, audio-visual technology, and the ability to troubleshoot minor technical issues during live broadcasts.
- Genuine passion for sports and a deep understanding of the role they play in the university community, fostering a spirited and supportive online atmosphere.
