Primary Responsibilities:

 Provide engaging and dynamic color commentary for Trent University varsity athletic events, creating an immersive experience for on-site spectators.



- Conduct thorough research on participating teams, players, and relevant statistics before each event to ensure accurate and insightful commentary during broadcasts.
- Make clear and concise public address announcements, including player introductions, score updates, and any other relevant information to enhance the overall fan experience.
- Work closely with the production team to coordinate timing, camera angles, and other technical aspects, ensuring a seamless and professional broadcast.
- Develop and deliver insightful features to add depth and context to the overall coverage.
- Assist in promoting varsity athletic events through various channels to increase attendance.

General Responsibilities:

- Uphold a high standard of professionalism in all interactions, representing Trent University and its athletic programs positively.
- Demonstrate flexibility in adapting announcing style based on the nature of the sport and the audience, ensuring an enjoyable experience for fans.
- Ensure accuracy in reporting scores, player names, and relevant statistics during broadcasts, contributing to the overall credibility of the sports coverage.
- Collaborate with fellow live commentators, production staff, and university officials to foster a cohesive and effective team environment.
- Stay informed about industry trends, new technologies, and best practices in sports announcing to enhance personal performance continually.
- Comply with all policies, regulations, and event protocols, including dress code.
- Perform any additional duties as assigned to support event success.

- Availability to work weekend shifts and flexible hours during game days
- Previous experience in sports broadcasting or live event commentary recommended
- In-depth knowledge of sports, rules, and strategies, particularly those relevant to Trent University's varsity athletic programs.
- Excellent verbal communication skills with the ability to articulate thoughts clearly and concisely, maintaining a captivating and energetic announcing style.
- Strong research abilities to gather and synthesize information quickly, ensuring well-prepared and informed commentary.
- Ability to adapt announcing style to different sports and audience preferences, demonstrating versatility in approach.
- Collaborative mindset and the ability to work effectively within a team, including production staff, event organizers, and fellow announcers.
- Familiarity with broadcasting equipment, audio-visual technology, and the ability to troubleshoot minor technical issues during live broadcasts.
- Genuine passion for sports and a deep understanding of the role they play in the university community, fostering a spirited and supportive atmosphere.
