Course Planning Sheet for Your Degree 20/21

By the end of first year, it is important to plan your courses for your entire degree. Many courses require pre-requisites to enroll. You must meet the requirements for your major, optional specialization, as well as your University degree requirements in order to graduate.

A Business Administration single or joint major has specific requirements. For example, a minimum grade of 60% is required in each of the following four required courses in order to graduate:

- ADMN 1000H – Contemporary Issues in Management
- ADMN 1221H – Financial Accounting
- ECON 1010H – Introductory Microeconomics
- ECON 1020H – Introductory Macroeconomics

Students pursuing a single major BBA degree may elect to take 1 of 9 Specializations: Accounting, Economics, Entrepreneurship, Ethics & Sustainability, Finance, Human Resources Management, Information Systems & E-commerce, Marketing & Consumer Culture or Niigaaniwin – the Art of Leading. Students can only obtain one specialization as part of their BBA degree. A minimum grade of 65% is required in each course counting towards a specialization. We cannot guarantee that all specialization courses will be offered in the same academic year.

University Degree Requirements:

- an Academic Status of “Good Standing” in your final year
- at least 3.0 credits, with a grade of 60% or higher, leading to majors in different disciplines [can include your major(s)]
- no more than 7.0 1000-level credits count towards your degree
- a maximum of one credit with a D grade (50 to 59%) in courses in a major or each joint-major or minor
- at least 0.5 credit from the Approved Indigenous Course List (see Academic Calendar). *This requirement applies to all students beginning studies at Trent in the Fall 2018 term or thereafter
- total credits required: 20.0 for Honours degree
- minimum Cumulative Average: 65% for Honours degree
- minimum credits required at the 3000- or 4000-level: 7.0 for Honours degree
- maximum credits allowed in a discipline: 13.0 for Joint Major Honours and does not apply for single major BBA degree
- required science credits, if applicable: 14 for Honours degree
- required math credit or equivalent, if applicable
- minimum credits taken at Trent University: 10.0 for Honours degree
- 5.0 of last 7.0 credits taken at Trent University
- REMEMBER TO APPLY TO GRADUATE

Please note that many ADMN required courses are offered in both the fall and winter term. Some electives are only offered in one term. The important planning piece is to make sure you have the pre-requisite in order to take an upper year course.

If you are in the dual degree Law and BBA program, make sure to follow the accelerated path.
