Readmission in the Master of Arts in Canadian Studies and Indigenous Studies Policy

(for students who have withdrawn or left the Program)

The student must arrange for their own supervisory committee (revised or new) consisting of a supervisor and two committee members.

Please contact the Frost Centre Office to determine the best mode of reapplication.

Depending on the time of year, you may be asked to resubmit through the OUAC system and to pay the application fee.

At a minimum, please provide the following information:

1. what term you wish to return? – example: Fall term 2022
2. full time or part time studies?
3. an updated address
4. an updated email

A re-written Plan of Study must include the names of the supervisor and committee members, a revised thesis topic description, any additional courses the student intends to take, and a timeline for the completion of the various components of the program. The School of Graduate Studies requires that this plan be approved by the reformed supervisor and committee. In addition, students applying for readmission must settle outstanding accounts prior to re-application.
