**5. Prime Minister Report ..... Maya Thomas**

- a. Download the Trent university mobile app [mobile@trentu.ca](mailto:mobile@trentu.ca)
- b. Course enrollment is up
- c. Tuition fees, services are at stake so there is no cut to tuition this semester. Bursaries are increased but need to be qualified.
- d. No summer camps, food services limited. Varsity teams are potentially running if individual, no team sports.
- e. Online orientation is highly suggested with remote learning in the fall.
- f. TCSA in discussion about aid in leaving leases with online courses.
- g. East vs West unlikely to happen with social distancing guidelines.
- h. New bus routes for students.

- j. On campus zoom calls if unable to participate safely at home.
- k. Athletics fees staying in tuition fee - online courses as an alternative.
- l. Remote learning: same timetable as previous years, however classes will be held online. Applies to all classes unlike traditional online learning. Some seminars and labs may have some in person classes. Fall and winter timetables will be done at the same time.

- n. Office Hours: If online, it has been suggested to hold in person hours for an hour every few weeks, however many students will come in during that one hour and may pose issues. Suggested by Sonia: have a few hours a week in person. Scotia: Zoom calls (or any platform) and hold office hours online in addition to in person. Luke: Moving to online office hours, however with College Office, there has been no participation with the students. Sarah: Having office hours increases opportunities for students to join if there are classes. Ruchi: Many questions were about getting around, one hour a week may be good. Maya: Email and booking office hours to work around other commitments.

  - i. First meeting, the TSCA has been working to try and expand the transit for schooling. Increase options for students not living in the main student center for housing.
