Today is Trent's Spring Open House and it sure has been a busy day for the College on the Hill. Continuing a tradition that started just a few years ago, Traill hosted a separate Open House beginning at 2 PM (or just after the main Open House on the Symons Campus ended). This year, a continuous bus loop ran from the Symons campus to Traill College and then onward to the new Traill Annex. I jumped on the first bus and led prospective students – and their families — downtown to show them the Traill experience. Tours of the College started in Scott House where visitors got to see the College Library, JCR, and SCR as well as the Academic Advising and Skills offices. From there, our visitors went on to tour the Crawford House and Wallis Hall residences. Visitors were encouraged to end their journey in The Trend where Chef Christopher had prepared a large feast of free sandwiches, cookies, and cakes with pots of tea and coffee. After experiencing Traill College, visitors then jumped back on the bus where they could make a stop at the new Traill Annex that will be opening in the Fall.

We are especially excited about the Traill Annex. Situated in the residence wing of the former Master's Bible College, the annex will offer 157 additional beds to new Traill College students. This will more than triple the number of residential students affiliated with Traill College. Situated near Hilliard St., the annex is just a five-minute drive, or 15-minute walk from Traill and all its student amenities. I wanted to offer thanks to all the people who help to organize this great event including the staff in Housing, Recruitment and Admissions, and Communications. A special thanks to all the student volunteers who acted as guides and to Traill College Coordinator, Samantha Perritt, for once again keeping everything on track throughout the day. ### **Backwoods Baking Presents:**

### S'mores Mug Cakes

#### **INGREDIENTS**

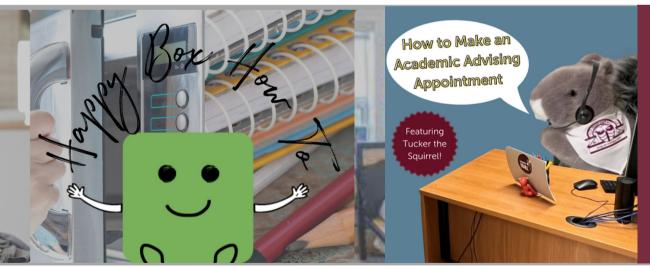
- 4 tablespoons butter
- 1 graham cracker, crushed to crumbs
- 3 tablespoons milk
- 1 large egg, whisked
- 4 tablespoons allpurpose flour
- 3 tablespoons sugar
- 3 tablespoons cocoa powder
- 1/2 teaspoon baking powder
- Kosher salt
- 32 mini or 4 large marshmallows

#### INSTRUCTIONS

- Melt 1 tablespoon of the butter in a microwave-safe mug. Add the graham cracker crumbs and stir to combine. Transfer half of the crumbs into another microwavesafe mug and press the crumbs down into the bottom of each mug.
- Melt the remaining 3 tablespoons butter in a microwave-safe bowl. Add the milk and egg and whisk to combine. Add the flour, sugar, cocoa powder, baking powder and a pinch of salt and whisk until smooth.
- Divide 1/4 of the batter into each mug and top each with 8 mini marshmallows or 1 large marshmallow. Divide the remaining batter into each mug and top each with 8 mini marshmallows or 1 large marshmallow.
- Microwave the mugs for 1 minute to 1
  minute 15 seconds, watching towards the
  end to make sure the cakes don't overflow.

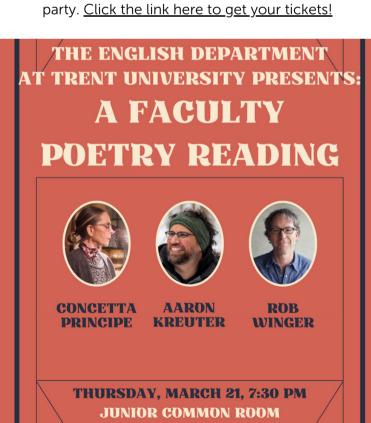

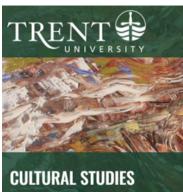


If you are looking for the time and focus to engage in the craft of writing and share your work with others, this is the workshop for you.

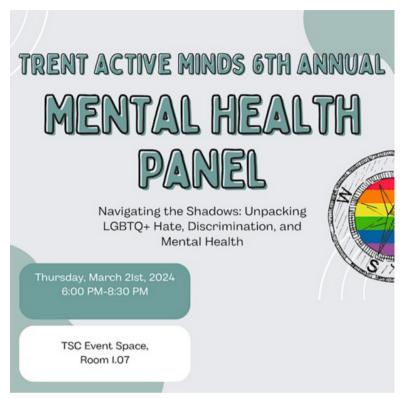

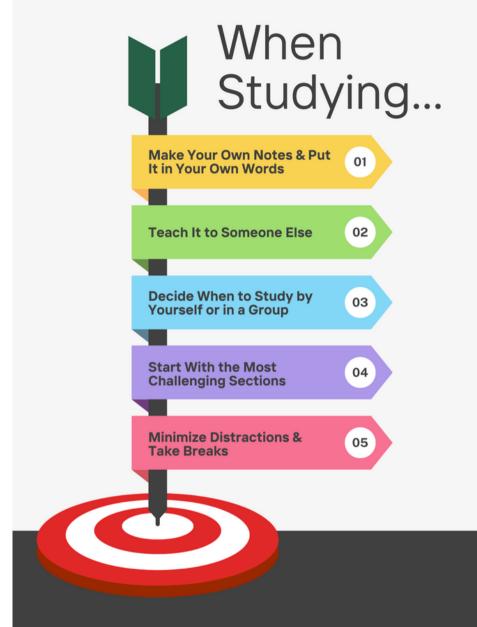
