



Glossary

- **Accessibility issues:**

All issues that have been found by the accessibility tool and cause difficulty for users with disabilities to access your website effectively. There are three categories of accessibility issues:

- Error (it is a problem)
- Warning (it is almost certainly a problem)
- Manual review needed (Running an automatic check to determine whether the guideline has been met is not possible, so manual review is needed)

- **Conformance levels: Level A, AA & AAA:**

Official levels of accessibility compliance as defined by the Web Content Accessibility Guidelines (WCAG) version 2

- Level A is considered to include the fundamental elements of accessibility
- Level AA is considered to be the next level of importance (typically the standard requirement in most countries)
- Level AAA is considered to be the final level of importance (100% AAA compliance may not be possible with certain types of content)

- **WCAG:**

Web Content Accessibility Guidelines. WCAG 2 is the second and most modern version of the accessibility guidelines, created by a group called the Web Accessibility Initiative (WAI), a part of the World Wide Web Consortium (W3C). The WCAG 2 guidelines are internationally-recognized and used in legislation and considered best practice in countries worldwide.
