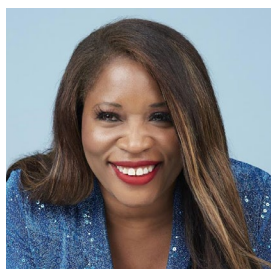

The most prestigious award conferred by Trent University is the honorary degree. It is granted to those individuals who have made extraordinary academic or social contributions to Canada or internationally, particularly in fields of relevance to Trent University or the wider regional community. *Doctor of Letters (D.Litt.)* recognizes contributions specifically in literature, arts and culture and *Doctor of Science (D.Sc.)* recognizes contributions in science and science policy.

Claudette McGowan is an internationally recognized technology executive and cybersecurity leader with more than 25 years of experience driving digital transformation at institutions such as Deloitte, Bank of Montreal, and TD Bank. Her current position is Chief Executive Officer of Protexxa, an innovative cybersecurity software and services company.

Claudette co-led the launch of Phoenix Fire & The Firehood, a multi-million-dollar women-focused angel fund and network for women in technology. She also founded the Black Arts and Innovation Expo and chairs the Coalition of Innovation Leaders against Racism.

Claudette has earned numerous accolades, including being named the Women's Executive Network's Top 100 Most Powerful Women in Canada.



Alice Olsen Williams/Minaajimokwe '69 (Otonabee College)

Honorary Doctor of Letters (D.Litt.)

Monday, June 9, 2025, 2:00 p.m. ceremony

Alice Olsen Williams / Minaajimokwe '69 is a world-renowned textile artist and Indigenous rights activist who is celebrated for creating more than 450 powerful quilted pieces that convey the deep cultural history of Indigenous communities. Her quilted blankets, wall hangings, and table runners are exhibited in galleries across Canada and the U.S., including the Royal Ontario Museum and the National Museum of the American Indian.

Olsen Williams uses her art to educate audiences on the history of institutional racism and the plight of missing and murdered Indigenous women and girls. A proud Trent graduate, she was honoured with the 2023 Spirit of Trent Award and is also the recipient of the City of Peterborough Arts Award.

Olsen Williams is also a tireless advocate who has served as a co-founder and chair of the Kawartha Truth and Reconciliation Support Group.
