General Admission Requirements
(from secondary school):

- Completion of secondary school certificate or diploma
- Minimum academic admission average of 70% (Canadian equivalency). Some programs require higher averages
- Applicants whose first language is not English are required to submit proof of English proficiency, meeting minimum requirements listed at trentu.ca/elp

FINANCING YOUR EDUCATION

Studying at Trent University in Canada is a valuable investment. We offer various financial support options to help reduce education costs, including scholarships, jobs, paid co-ops, and internships.

Automatic Entrance Scholarships
All international undergraduate applicants with 80% average or higher are automatically considered for scholarships ranging from CAD \$1,500 to CAD \$4,000 per year. These awards are renewable annually for up to CAD \$16,000 over 4 years based on academic performance.

Prestigious International Scholarships
(Undergraduate, Application Required)
Top international students demonstrating academic excellence, leadership, and financial need may receive scholarships of up to CAD \$40,000 per year (maximum CAD \$160,000 over four years).

On-campus & Off-campus Jobs
Part-time jobs on and off campus provide financial support and valuable work experience, helping students integrate into the community and local economy.

Paid Co-op Programs
Gain up to 12 months of paid work experience related to your field, enhancing your resume and skills.

Placements & Internships
Earn academic credit while gaining practical experience in various industries.

Graduate Admissions Requirements

- Honours bachelor’s degree (a four-year undergraduate bachelor’s degree or equivalent) for entry into a Master’s degree
- Master’s degree or equivalent for entry into a doctoral degree
- Minimum B+ (77% Ontario grade or equivalent) in the last two years of full-time study
- All applicants must provide proof of English proficiency.
- Application requirements vary by program.

Graduate Scholarships & Funding

At Trent, all eligible full-time Master’s and Ph.D. students in research-based programs receive competitive funding, which may include graduate teaching assistantships, research fellowships, or entrance scholarships, which are outlined in the Offer of Admission.

Professional (course-based) programs do not include funding in the offer. Students in these programs are expected to self-fund.

\$ Top applicants to the Master of Management or Applied Modelling streams may receive a Graduate Distinguished Entrance Scholarship of up to \$3,000. No application required.
