Graduate Admissions Requirements

- Honours bachelor's degree (a four-year undergraduate bachelor's degree or equivalent) for entry into a Master's degree
- Master's degree or equivalent for entry into a doctoral degree
- Minimum B+ (77% Ontario grade or equivalent) in the last two years of full-time study
- All applicants must provide proof of English proficiency.
- Application requirements vary by program.

Graduate Scholarships & Funding

At Trent, all eligible full-time Master's and Ph.D. students in research-based programs receive competitive funding, which may include graduate teaching assistantships, research fellowships, or entrance scholarships, which are outlined in the Offer of Admission.
