WHAT DO I NEED TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR EACH PROGRAM?

General Admission Requirements & Recommendations for School of Business Programs

- Admission Average: 70% minimum
- Course Requirements: ENG4U, Any 4U Math
- Recommendations: MHF4U Advanced Functions
- Co-op Admission Average: 80% minimum

Higher minimum entering averages are required for:

- Law & Business Dual Degree: 80% minimum
- Financial Science: 75% minimum
- Logistics & Supply Chain Management: 75% minimum
- B.B.A. & Master of Management Fast Track Program: 80% minimum

EXPERIENTIAL LEARNING & CO-OP

Paid Co-op

Gain a competitive edge for your future career. Trent's B.B.A. co-op, B.B.A. Accounting co-op, Accounting & Economics co-op, and Economics co-op streams give you the opportunity to explore your strengths and career interests, and graduate with 12 months of work experience (and income).

- Students taking the Business (B.B.A.) co-op may pursue any of our available specializations.
- Students in the paid co-op streams will study in the summer terms, including the summer term after fourth-year.

Paid Internships

Fourth-year students in Business, Accounting, and Economics (single majors) can complete an internship, a paid work term ranging from 6 to 16 months.

Placements

Fourth-year students in Business, Accounting, and Economics majors also have the option of completing a placement, gaining practical career experience working (normally unpaid) one-day per week with an organization during the academic term. Placements are also open to joint majors.

PROFESSIONAL QUALIFICATIONS & CERTIFICATIONS

Chartered Professional Accountant (CPA) Designation

Students in the Accounting specialization who take a few more accounting courses and meet the grade requirements are eligible to enter the CPA Professional Education Program.

Certified Human Resources Professional (CHRP) Designation

Students who successfully complete our Human Resource Management specialization and meet the grade requirements are eligible to write the Human Resource Professionals Association's CHRP Knowledge and Employment Law exams.
