Guided by the four dimensions of the circle – physical, emotional, spiritual, and mental wellbeing - Indigenous students will experience learning on Peterborough the land, engage in intergenerational learning with elders, be immersed in 5 years (Concurrent) community-based initiatives and forward the movement toward social and ecological justice. #### **Medical Professional Stream for Indigenous Students**

Self-identification as First Nations, Métis or Inuit required.

This pathway for Indigenous students provides you with a clear and well-supported route to medical, dental, or veterinary school. A minimum 80% average is required for consideration.

- Minimum 70% overall final average
- ENG 4U with a minimum of 60%

- Minimum 80% overall final average
