TRANSFER FROM COLLEGE

Earn your bachelor's degree faster

Earn both a college diploma and a Trent degree in a fraction of the time thanks to agreements with colleges spanning the GTA and across Ontario. It's the best of both worlds – combining practical and career focused learning, critical analysis and academic learning foundations. Where will your path lead you?

Two ways to transfer to Trent from College

1 Transfer into (almost) any Trent degree: Transfer credits from college can be applied to nearly any Trent program. We will work with you to assess and make sure you are making the most of your credits.

2 Transfer through a designated pathway: With 275+ pathways with colleges across Ontario, transferring to Trent is easy. **Explore our transfer pathways database** to find your best path to a Trent degree. Be sure to check the database regularly – we are adding new pathways all the time!



General Admission Requirements for College Transfer Students

- If you have completed at least one semester in a recognized Canadian college, with a cumulative average of 65% (2.0 GPA on a scale of 4.0), you are eligible for admission to many programs at Trent
- Two-semesters of many college program courses can be used to satisfy many degree program pre-requisites
- The minimum course average needed for automatic transfer credit assessment is 70%
- Transfer credits outlined in a designated pathway may require a higher cumulative average



WHAT ARE TRANSFER CREDITS?

Transfer credits refer to courses taken at one institution that are credited toward a degree or diploma at another institution. Up to 10.0 transfer credits (or the equivalent of up to two years), may be applied to your honours degree at Trent University.

TRANSFER FROM ANOTHER UNIVERSITY

Transfer into nearly any program at Trent

With a 20:1 student-to-faculty ratio, Trent offers an educational experience that unfolds on a human scale. Prepare to be embraced by our collegiate community and engage directly with renowned experts who will quickly become your favourite faculty members.

Minimum Admission Requirements for University Transfer Students

- One semester in an accredited Canadian university, with a cumulative average of 65% (2.0 GPA on a scale of 4.0) will be considered for admission to Trent University
- A minimum grade of 60% is required in any university course to be considered for course-by-course transfer credit assessment
- Up to a maximum of 10.0 credits (two years of full time study) may be applied to an undergraduate honours degree at Trent University
- One semester of a university course can be used to satisfy pre-requisites

- 1 APPLY TO TRENT**
Apply directly to Trent by visiting trentu.ca/transfer and we will waive the application fee.
- 2 SEND YOUR TRANSCRIPTS**
If you're in your first semester of first year, send your transcripts once grades become available.

If you have completed your first semester, send in your transcripts with your application.
- 3 RECEIVE YOUR OFFER**
Successful applicants will receive an offer of admission by email.
- 4 ACCEPT YOUR OFFER**
Be sure to accept your offer of admission as early as possible as some programs and courses have limited enrolment and may fill up quickly.
