English language proficiency

Applicants are required to demonstrate an adequate level of English proficiency, regardless of their citizenship status or country of origin. The following tests are acceptable forms of proof of English language proficiency:

- TOEFL IBT: 4.5 (4.5 in writing and 4.0 in speaking)
- IELTS Academic: 6.5 (6.0 in all bands)
- CAEL or CAEL online: 60 (60 in Writing)
- PTE Academic: 60 (60 in all bands)
- Cambridge English Qualifications C1 Advanced/C2 Proficiency: 176 (169 in all bands)

Some applicants may be exempt from providing proof of English language proficiency tests. Please scan the QR code for more details.
