- Minimum academic admission average of 70% (Canadian equivalency). Some programs require higher averages.
- Applicants whose first language is not English are required to submit proof of English proficiency, meeting minimum requirements listed at trentu.ca/elp

Graduate Admissions Requirements

- **Master’s Entry:** Honours bachelor’s degree (4-year or equivalent)
- **Doctoral Entry:** Master’s degree or equivalent
- **GPA:** Minimum B+ (77% Ontario grade or equivalent) in the last two years of full-time study
- **Language:** Proof of English proficiency required for all applicants
