At Trent, the study of Business extends beyond the School of Business. Additional degree offerings allow students to explore how business principles intersect with economics, finance, data, mathematics, technology, and organizational systems through a range of specialized programs and pathways.

Economics (B.A.) **Paid Co-op Available**

Explore how markets and policy at the macro and micro level shape the global economy. Through the study of markets, public policy, international trade, and economic development, you will develop analytical and problem-solving skills that can be applied across industries and sectors.

Financial Science (B.Sc.) **Paid Co-op Available**

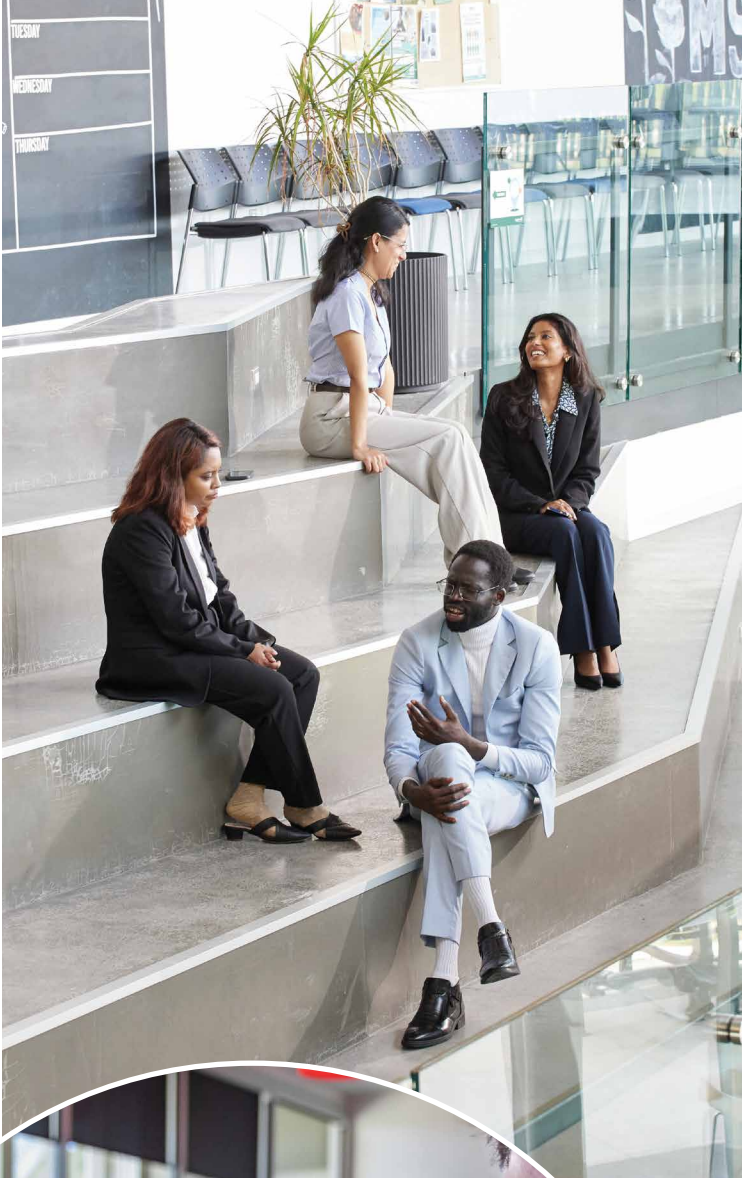

Mathematical Economics (B.Sc.)

Examine economic questions through mathematical modelling and quantitative analysis. This program is ideal for students who enjoy working with data and exploring how economic theories can be used to understand complex issues affecting markets, organizations, and society.

Supply Chain Management (B.A.)

Study how products, services, information, and resources move through organizations and global markets. As businesses place greater focus on efficiency, resilience, and sustainability, Supply Chain Management graduates are increasingly sought after across a wide range of industries.

Put Business into Practice

Business acumen is learned through experience. At Trent, opportunities to apply your knowledge begin early and continue throughout your degree. Through paid co-op, internships, placements, entrepreneurship challenges, community partnerships, networking opportunities, and industry-connected experiences, students build practical skills, professional confidence, and valuable connections before graduation.

Paid Co-op

Gain up to 12 months of paid work experience during your degree through paid co-op streams available in Business Administration, Business Administration (Accounting), Accounting & Economics, and Economics. Co-op allows students to apply their learning in professional settings, explore career interests, build industry connections, and graduate with experience already on their resume. Co-op work terms take place during the summer term after fourth year.

Students in the Business B.B.A. co-op stream can pursue any available specialization other than Accounting.

Internships

Take your learning into the workplace through a paid internship lasting between 6 and 16 months. Available to fourth-year Business and Economics students, internships provide an opportunity to gain meaningful professional experience, build your network, and explore potential career paths before graduation.

Placements

Work directly with an organization while earning academic credit. Placements allow students to apply their business knowledge to real projects and challenges, gaining professional experience one day per week throughout the academic term in fourth year. Placement opportunities are available to Business, Economics, and joint major students.

Turn Your Ideas into Action

Graduate with the skills to think and act like an expert or entrepreneur. Through opportunities like the Business STRIDE Challenge at our Durham GTA campus and the \$100 Start Up Project at our Peterborough campus, you will pitch business solutions and learn what it takes to launch your own start-up, all while receiving mentorship from experts and gaining real business experience that stands out on a resume.

Through Trent’s community-based research opportunities, you can work alongside local organizations to tackle real challenges while earning academic credit. Funding Your Education

Renewable Entrance Scholarships

Attention top scholars! Undergraduate students with an entering average of 95%+ are awarded full first-year tuition. Achieve an average of 80% or higher and you automatically receive an entrance scholarship – no application required. And it’s not just a one-time thing. Trent’s national entrance scholarships are RENEWABLE each year. When you maintain an 80% average each year, this can really pay off – with a total scholarship potential of \$18,000.

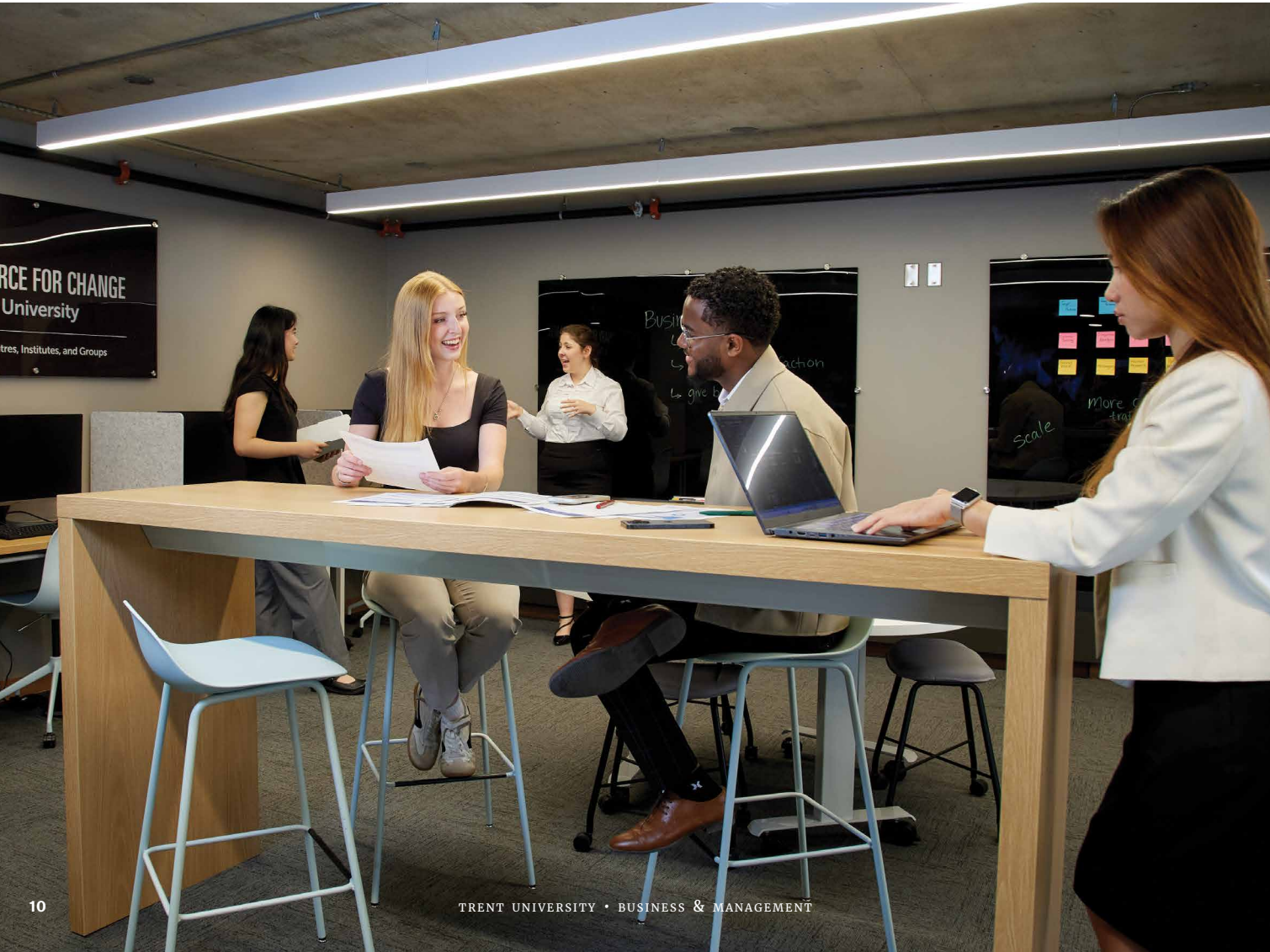
