



FULL UNIVERSITY CREDITS FOR ESL

The Trent-ESL pathway program now offers more value for your English language learning. Our two highest ESL levels are now credit courses. This means that your ESL studies are now part of your degree. Trent is the only university in Canada granting full university credits for English as a Second Language that can be applied to all Trent undergraduate degrees.

Now ESL students can finish Trent-ESL with up to 3 complete credits. This represents 60% of your first year of university study!


Earn ESL and Undergraduate Credits

- Full orientation program and placement testing to ensure you are best prepared for your undergraduate education at Trent
- Upper ESL levels Academic English 1 and 2 are now undergraduate courses for credit towards your degree. Each course is worth one full undergraduate credit.
- Students in Academic English 1 and 2 can also study in additional undergraduate courses (restrictions apply)
- During ESL, students can earn up to three full undergraduate credits of the required twenty credits needed to achieve a four-year honours degree
- Academic support from start to finish with our top ESL professors and advisors
- Full access to all services and facilities, including our stunning riverside gymnasium, Bata library, laboratories, student centre, 12 nature reserves, and more!
- Small classes and weekly one-on-one tutoring sessions (writing conferences) with your ESL professor
- Extracurricular programs, clubs, and field trips to meet friends from Canada and around the world

Placement Test

- A 75-minute adaptive multiple-choice online test that tests reading, vocabulary and listening.
- A 60-minute writing test that asks students to read a short article and complete a
 writing task based on the article. Students are assigned either a beginner writing
 test or an advanced writing test based on their on online test score. The writing
 test is offered in person or online as needed.







COURSE 1: ACADEMIC ANALYSIS

Having the ability to critically analyze what you read and listen to is an important skill to have at university! In your undergraduate degree, you are required to evaluate, critique and build upon the ideas and theories you come across, rather than describing what you have learned.

In the Trent-ESL Academic Analysis classes, we will teach you how to read academic articles and take effective lecture notes. Starting with that base, you'll learn to demonstrate your understanding of the issues through your written and oral analysis.

COURSE 2: ACADEMIC COMMUNICATION

The global importance of English continues to increase in all aspects. English is used as the primary language of international commerce and diplomacy, of science, aviation, and Information Technology, and for international communication, the media, and the Internet. It is therefore critical to learn comprehensive productive skills i.e. Writing and Speaking, in English.

Academic Communication will develop your writing and speaking skills through a focus on content-integrated learning. This is to say, every language lesson will teach you the academic writing and speaking skills you'll need for success in your degree by examining "real-life" topics taught in university courses. In Academic Communication you'll practice writing different kinds of short essays as well as longer academic papers. You'll also be given many different opportunities to speak in group discussions and presentations on a variety of topics. Grammar and Vocabulary are infused into Writing and Speaking lessons as essential building blocks of effective communication. The goal of Trent-ESL Instructors is to enable students to handle English communication well -- and when students do, the learning process has been successful.








English for Business & Entrepreneurship
