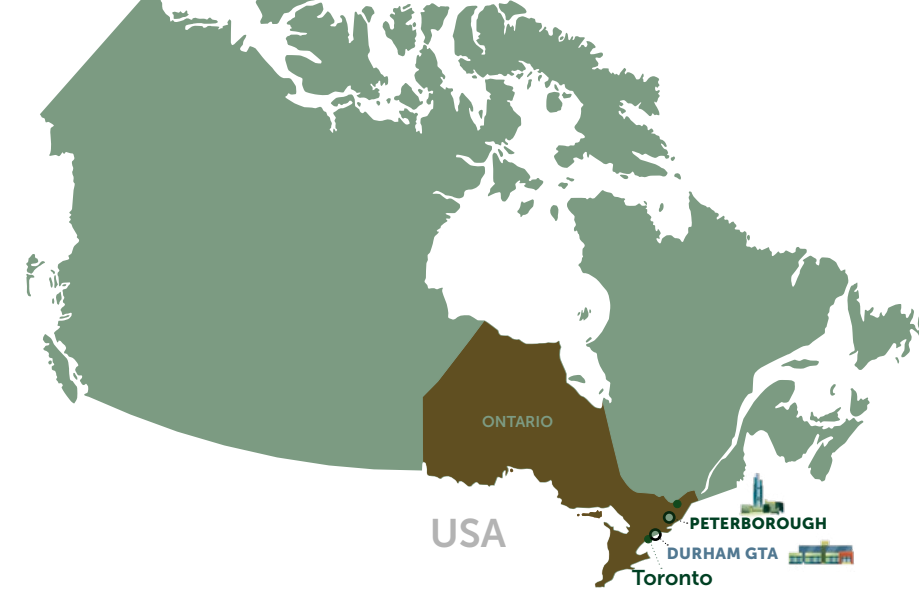

Post Graduation Work Permit

Upon completion of an in-person postgraduate certificate, students are eligible to apply for a Post Graduation Work Permit (PGWP). The duration of this document can range from eight months to a maximum of three years, corresponding to the length of the academic program, as per IRCC guidelines. Qualifying Canadian work experience accrued while holding a PGWP can be used towards applications for Permanent Residence.

A PGWP is a practical way to apply what you've learned at Trent, advance your professional goals and gain Canadian work experience, which you might need to qualify for certain permanent resident programs.

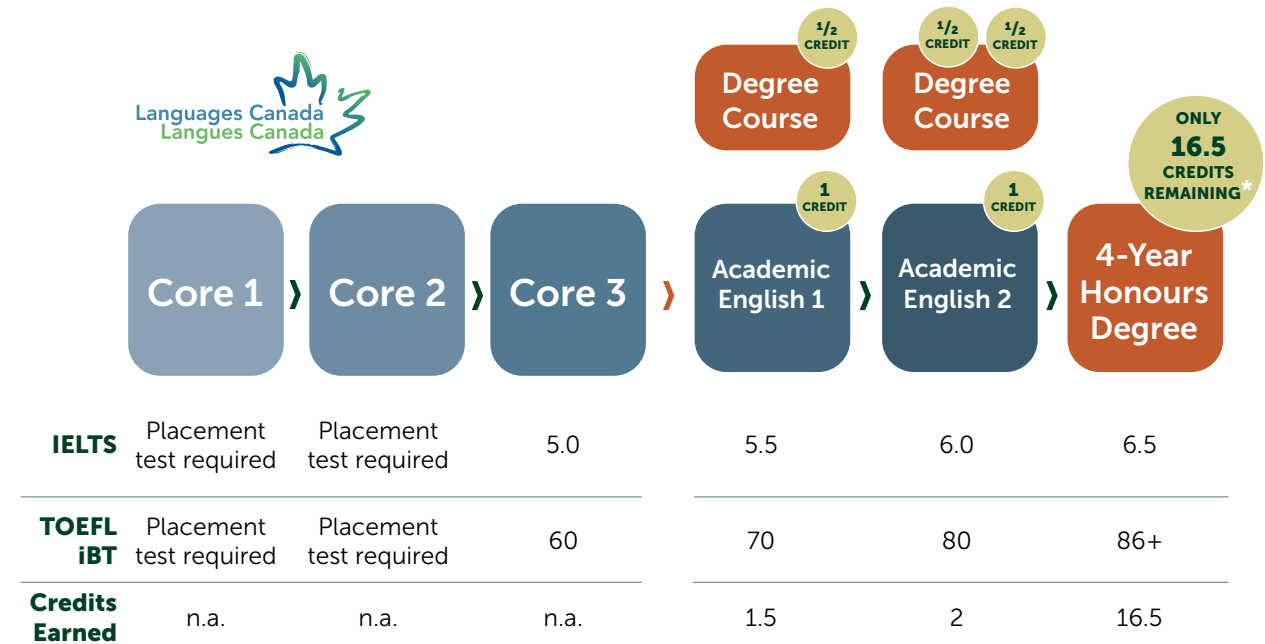

ADMISSIONS PATHWAYS

- **Trent-ESL: English for University** – for applicants who require English proficiency for full admission to Trent. No IELTS or TOEFL score is required for this program, but can be submitted for direct placement to some levels. trentu.ca/esl
- **Trent-ESL: Academic English Program** – for applicants who are admitted to Trent and have a 5.5 IELTS or TOEFL iBT 70. Two terms of for-credit Academic English courses, with the option to add up to 3 academic program courses. Applicants who do not meet the IELTS/TOEFL score requirement can progress from Trent-ESL CORE 1-3 with no English proficiency score required. trentu.ca/esl
- **Trent Elevate Program** – for applicants who require both English proficiency and academic upgrading. Successful completion of this program leads to full time undergraduate programs. trentu.ca/elevate
- **Degree Progression Pathway** – for applicants requiring academic upgrading for full admission to Trent. Successful completion of this program leads to full time undergraduate study in selected programs. trentu.ca/dpp
