An open scholarship was made available to doctoral candidates in the Environmental and Life Science graduate program through the generosity of *The French American Charitable Trust*. The purpose of the award is to recognize a high level of scholarship and original thought.

Eligibility: All doctoral ENLS registered students are eligible to apply

Deadline: February 26th, 2021 by 3:00 p.m.

Successful applicants will be notified by the end of April 2021

Application Procedure:

ENLS students must submit an application consisting of:

1. Cover letter highlighting scientific achievement (one page)
2. Outline of their original and innovative thesis research (one page)
3. C.V.

Due to the COVID restrictions:

- Submit application as a complete package via e-mail to lcardwell@trentu.ca
- Include in email subject line **French-American Scholarship Submission**

All documents must be included. Do not submit individual pieces or send items separately. The office will not assemble, add to or take out items from your application package.

Adjudication:

All submissions will be evaluated upon the following criteria:

- Scientific interest
- Novelty
- Clarity of the argument
- Presentation.

The committee will review all applications taking into consideration the innovation and original thinking requisite in a Ph.D. candidate.
