

WHAT TO BRING TO RESIDENCE

Traditional Style Rooms & Apartment/Suite Style

- School supplies (pens, pencils, etc.)
- Binders/ Agenda
- Lined Paper or Notebooks
- Backpack
- Headphones
- Hangers
- Linens (Comforter, Sheets, Bedding)
- Pillows
- Towels
- Hairdryer/Hairbrush
- Alarm Clock
- Computer/ Laptop
- Chargers
- Extension Cords
- Printer (Trent does have on campus printers)
- Painters tape (Hanging up pictures and decorations)
- Posters, Photos, Personalized decorations
- Laundry Hamper
- Microwave (All common rooms do have one)
- Coffee-Maker (Keurig or Tassimo)
- Cups/Plates/Cutlery
- Mini Fridge (4 cubic ft, you can also rent one from Coldex)
- Bikes (There are plenty of Bike storage and Bike racks outside of most main entrances)

Apartment/Suite Style

(In addition to above)

- Cooking equipment (kettle with automatic shut off, toaster, microwave)
- Dishes, cutlery, pots/pans
- Decorations or personalized items for living area/kitchen space

Cleaning Supplies

- Lysol wipes
- Surface Disinfectant
- Laundry Soap / Detergent
- Disposable Gloves

Personal Items

- Toiletries
- Shower Caddy
- Personal Handsoap
- Toothbrush/Toothpaste
- Non-medical face masks
- Hand Sanitizer (We also recommend you bring some pocket size ones as well)
- Shower Shoes
- Immunization Records
- Health Equipment (anything you require, such as: thermometer, first aid kit, etc.)

What NOT to bring to Residence

- Beer Bottles
- Drinking Paraphernalia
- Illegal Drugs or Cultivation Equipment
- Subwoofers/Large Speakers
- Drum Sets
- Electric Guitars
- Cooking Equipment (open heat sources are not allowed in residence rooms)
- Space Heaters
- Candles or incense
- Pets (unless approved by Housing Services)
- Workout Machines
- Duct tape and other adhesives that can damage paint
Note: you cannot put holes in the walls so no power tools
- Curtains, shower curtains, blinds (they are provided in all residence rooms)
- Additional Furniture
- Any sort of weaponry
