### **DESCRIPTION OF COURSE AND DUTIES:**

Practice course involving independent placement in a community setting (public health, clinics, agencies, schools). The student explores a specific topic of interest related to health promotion or population health. Supported by Learning Centre activities relevant to practice in community including interviewing skills, immunization, and assessment (developmental, mental health, sexual).

# Clinical Instructor - Mobile Health Unit is responsible for:

- Direct supervision of students engaged in activities of the outreach clinics, including set-up/takedown, registration of clients, gathering and documenting health histories, completing health equity questionnaires, and basic assessments including vital signs.
- Driving the outreach vehicle equipped with medical supplies and students to the various outreach locations
- Monitoring and ordering supplies for the outreach vehicle.
- Ensuring vehicle receives regular maintenance as per Trent Policies.
- Weekly seminar facilitation
- Evalution of each individual student's progress at midterm and following completion of clinical hours; Final evaluations of students in clinical placements will occur after the completion of clinical placement
- Timely and continuous feedback to students on clinical experience, clinical assignments and reflections as per course syllabus
- Attendance at faculty orientation, clinical orientation, course meetings
- Submitting completed signed evaluation forms (electronic preferred) to the School of Nursing Office within two weeks of course completion
- Noting absences, late, ill days/hours on evaluation forms

- Consulting with the Course Coordinator or BScN Program Coordinator as required in the course syllabus
- Attendance required for streethealth simulation and windshield walking survey (both outdoors)
- Regular communication with the preceptor.

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#### **QUALIFICATIONS:**

- Masters degree in nursing, nursing education, or directly related field preferred.
- Baccalaureate degree in nursing required.
- Experience as an RN in a primary healthcare role.
- Experience with Telus RSS EMR preferred.
- Employee of a Community Health Centre preferred.
- Must possess a valid Class G driver's license (or equivalent), maintain a clean driving record and meet all requirements to be insured under the University's insurance policy.
- Ability to safely operate a pick-up truck for work-related duties, including transporting equipment, supplies and students.
- Evidence of continued professional development in nursing.
- Must be a member in good standing with the College of Nurses of Ontario.
- Ability to meet non-academic requirements by the deadline date specified for the relevant term(s) to be obtained and submitted once the job offer has been made.
