## CONDITIONS

1. Only tickets that have been paid for and/or been verified as paid for are eligible to be entered for the respective draw/s. The licensee is to ensure that this requirement is strictly adhered to.

The draw must be held on the date(s), and time(s) specified on the application for Licence, as submitted and approved by the Registrar, regardless of the outcome of the raffle ticket sales. Failure to hold a draw as specified is a breach of the Terms and Conditions of this Licence.

Any prizes which are not claimed must be secured or placed in safekeeping for a period of six (6) months from the date of the draw. If at the end of six (6) months the prize has still not been claimed, the prize or monies equivalent to the fair market value of the prize must be donated to a beneficiary approved by the licensing authority.

Licensee must indicate the detailed procedures to be followed for all draws and for all prizes to be awarded and any other procedures including those which a spectator may expect to see during the draws.

Licensees are responsible for compliance with the raffle license terms and conditions and any additional terms attached to the license. Samples of print advertising and scripts for radio/TV are submitted to the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario for review as part of the licensing process. The AGCO does not approve advertising. It remains the responsibility of the licensee to ensure that advertising content complies with the Terms and Conditions and any other requirements. The Registrar of alcohol and gaming has the right to require a licensee to remove or amend

advertising at any time.

Lottery report including Licence fees must be submitted within 15 days following the end of each month in which draws are carried out. The licensee shall also provide a verified financial statement within 180 days of the organization's year end outlining the financial details of the raffle lottery conducted during that year.

Licensee is required to maintain a proper audit trail in respect of the sale of tickets. A detailed submission of the sale of single and discounted tickets is required to be submitted with the lottery report and listing names of winners and amounts won.

This 50/50 lottery is restricted to the employees of Trent University personnel only.

Any incidents, including those related to technical integrity of the gaming system, occurring before or during the electronic raffle event must be reported by the licensee to the Registrar within a specific timeframe. The Notification Matrix - Electronic Raffles (available at www.agco.ca) lists all the incident types that must be reported.

Any changes in the application must be made before a license number has been assigned and will require the approval of the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario.

This licence must be readily available at all times. This licence is not transferable.
