Eligible* new and returning graduate students must submit the following to apply for a GTA position:

- cover letter containing a **statement of interest**
- up-to-date CV
- GTA Supplementary Form

PLEASE NOTE:

- New this year, you will be required to submit a **GTA Supplementary Form**, which will be included in an email to all eligible graduate students from the Office of the Deans, Arts and Science.
- Your **statement of interest** should include your **top three course preferences for each term**. Please also keep in mind the qualifications listed for each course.
- Preferences are not guaranteed.
- **A complete application package (listed above) is required to receive a GTA position. The hiring department will not assign an eligible student to a course if they have not applied.**
- The courses listed above are conditional to have a GTA pending budgetary approval and projected enrolment.
