

## **Bimaadiziwin/Atonhetseri:io Presentations**

1. Submit a report authored by the Elder/Knowledge Holder that you apprenticed with detailing the progress and your successful completion of the apprenticeship. The report can be a simple letter stating that you've worked with them and what skill(s) you have learned, as well as sharing a general idea of the duration of time you spent together.
2. Write a 5-to-6-page paper (12 point font, double-spaced) that summarizes your apprenticeship with the Knowledge Holder/Elder, the insights gained and connection to your life and learning. The paper is due the Director of Studies no later than two weeks prior to your presentation to the PhD Traditional Council. The paper will be shared with the Traditional Council with the intention of preparing the council to witness your presentation and engage in a dialogue with you about your apprenticeship.
3. You will give a 30 minute presentation to some of the Elders and Knowledge Holders from the PhD Traditional Council. There will be 10-minute rounds of questions.
4. This presentation will ideally be in person.
