




Getting Started With Esri Training

As part of Trent’s Campus Site License to Esri products, registered members of Trent University can access Esri Online Training by logging in through an assigned login. To begin training, follow the steps below:

1. Obtain your Trent “Enterprise Account” User ID and Password, from Trent University [Maps, Data & Government Information Centre](#) by completing the [form](#) found at: https://trentu.ca/library/sites/default/files/documents/MaDGIC_TrentEsriGlobalAccount_UserAgreement.pdf
2. Go to the Esri Training Catalog at: <https://www.esri.com/training/catalog/>
3. At the top right of the screen, press “Sign In”.
