Year 1 & 2 Helpful Tips

If you were admitted without PSYC 1020H & 1030H transfer credits, it means you received 1.0 (or two 0.5) transfer credits in other courses. You must take PSYC 1020H and 1030H in the terms where those credits apply. For example, if you have a transfer credit for BIOL 1051H but not PSYC 1020H, take PSYC 1020H in Year 1, Semester 2.

Year 2 & 3 Helpful Tips

NURS 3560H can count as either a 3000-level elective or a Semester 5 forced-choice elective.

Advanced Topic List: NURS 4005H, 4009H, 4100H, 4102H, 4103H, 4104H, 4105H, 4106H, 4108H, 4109H, 4201H, 4203H, 4204H, 4205H, 4207H, 4208H. A thesis, NURS 4011H and 4012H can be taken in place of the advanced topics. It is 2 semesters in length and therefore would count as both Advanced Topics.
