Year 1 & 2 Helpful Tips

If you were admitted without PSYC 1020H & 1030H transfer credits, it means you received 1.0 (or two 0.5) transfer credits in other courses. You must take PSYC 1020H and 1030H in the terms where those credits apply. For example, if you have a transfer credit for BIOL 1501H but not PSYC 1020H, take PSYC 1020H in Year 1, Semester 2.

NURS 3560H can count as either a 3000-level elective or a Semester 5 forced-choice elective.
