How much will a year at Trent University Cost?

Expense	Amount
Tuition (billed per credit)	\$6,118
Fees	\$766
Books & Supplies	\$2686
Total Educational Cost: *2023-2024	\$9570



Financial Aid Timeline

WHEN	WHAT
March – Aug.	Scholarship offers sent automatically
May	OSAP application (now!)
June – August	External awards, summer job, save money!
Sept. & Jan.	In-course Bursary Applications




Trent's National Renewable Entrance Scholarships

- No application required
- Based on Admissions Average
 - George Brown cumulative average
- Renewable for years 3 and 4 at Trent
- Must achieve 80% average in 5.0 Trent credits to renew

Admission Average	Scholarship Value
80-84%	\$1,000
85-89%	\$1,500
90-94%	\$2,500
95% +	\$3,000



Bursaries



- Bursaries awarded based on financial need and require an application
- Students must be in receipt of OSAP (or comparable government student assistance program) to be eligible for bursary assistance
- Apply every semester you are studying (September and January & May)
- MyTrent: UG Bursary Application

 (apply through myTrent portal under the FINANCES tab)



What is OSAP?



Introduction

Find out how much you could get to help pay for your postsecondary education.

It takes only 5-10 minutes to complete. You'll need:

- · school and program
- dates the program starts and ends
- tuition and book costs
- your parent's or spouse's income (the tool will determine if you need this information)

When do your classes start?



• Ontario.ca/OSAP

- Government student assistance program for Ontario residents
- Amount of funding based on several variables
- Combination of Federal and Provincial Loans and Grants
- Grants = Money you keep
- Loan = Money you pay back



OSAP Application Steps

There are just 4 steps to the application! It will take you about 15 minutes to complete.



School & program

Tell us what school you're going to and what program you're taking. More info



About you

Tell us if you're single or married and where you live. You'll need to share personal and financial



About your family

You might need to share information about your parents, spouse or children.

Submit

Review your application, submit it and track the status. More info


OSAP Estimated Funding



Five things to remember!







Any changes need to be reported to OSAP using the myTrent form – course load, income, etc.



You do not report your Trent Scholarship; We will report it for you



You must always be in at least 1.5 credits a semester (60%)*. **REGISTER FOR FALL AND WINTER**



You must reapply for OSAP every year

Summer Opportunities

Some of you might want to get a head start on your Trent degree by starting courses this summer:

- If you take three or more courses during the summer you can apply for full time OSAP and bursaries with Trent as your school

** If you are a student with a permanent disability two half credits over the 12 weeks is full time
