The undergraduate academic timetable is now available for Peterborough, Durham and Online courses.

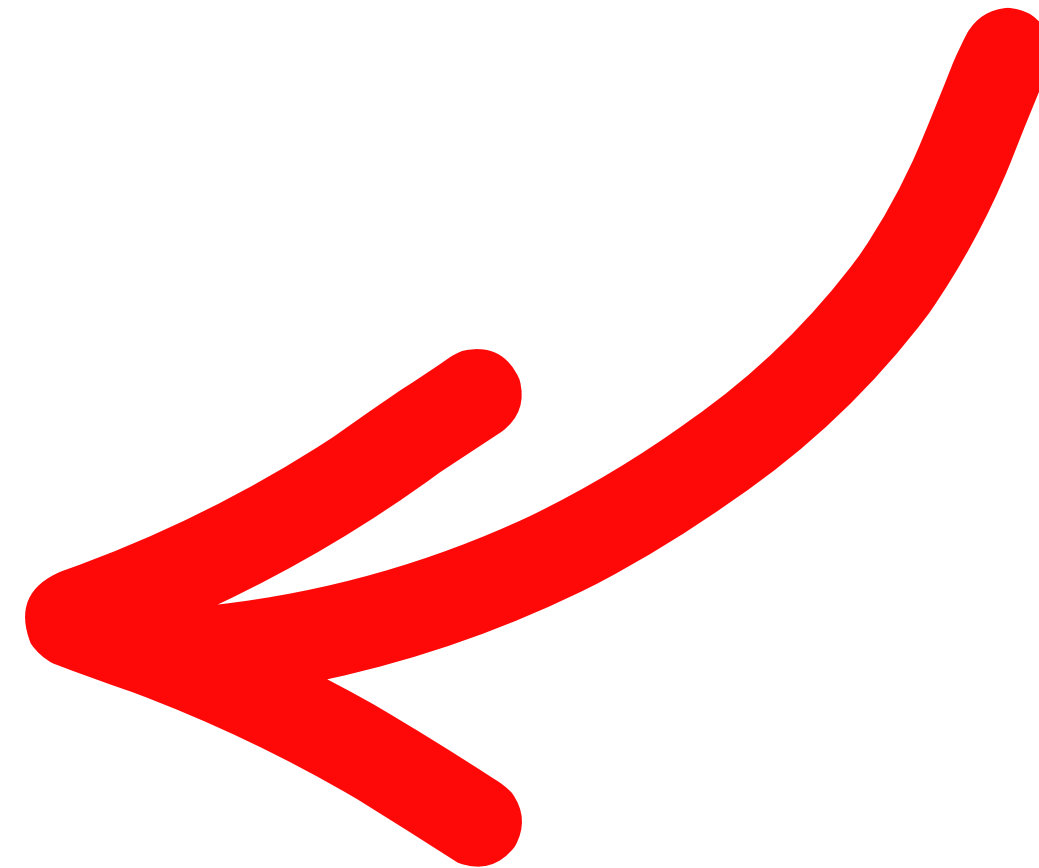

Priority registration runs from June 16-25, 2026. During priority registration, you can register in courses in your declared major(s) for which you have prerequisites and in any courses which do not have approved limited enrolment.
