This annual award recognizes the Trent University researcher or research team stewarding original and impactful research which has contributed significantly to society (local, regional, national or international).

<u>Deadline for submissions:</u>	<u>Who is eligible for award nomination?</u>
March 20, 2026	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Any faculty, staff, post doc, adjunct, associate or team affiliated with Trent University research can nominate or stand for nomination• The individual, or if a team, the Principal Investigator, must be formally affiliated with Trent University for at least 3 years• Self-nomination is acceptable• Students are not eligible for this award, unless they are key members of the nominated research team

Selection Criteria:

- Demonstrated impact of research beyond the university community (reach) - refers to the extent to which the research has been disseminated and engaged with by audiences beyond traditional academic circles and/or among underrepresented groups, e.g. community outreach, media engagement, and knowledge mobilization;
- Demonstrated impact of research exceeding regular or expected activity (exceptionality) - refers to the significant and measurable changes brought about by the research in terms of thought, practice, policy, and/or societal benefits.

The Vice President, Research & Innovation (VPRI) will share the top three nominations with the Research Policy Committee (representing faculty, TCSA and GSA) in April of each year for the Committee's recommendation of the successful nomination. The VPRI will present the award at the Heart of Trent employee appreciation event in May of each year. The award includes a framed certificate and a \$500 cash award for investment in the research project if still ongoing or promotion of same if already completed.
