Our graduate programs operate on a trimester basis, and in a hybrid mode, students can choose virtual or face-to-face instruction. Except for the occasional courses that may be taught in English, all our courses are taught in Spanish. The academic year encompasses four study periods. International students may join us for one, two, three, or four trimesters, depending on their school's agreement.

### **VISITING STUDENT:**

Visiting students are welcomed, but they must be full-time students registered in a university-level program. Additionally, they must have successfully accredited one full year of their degree.

Please contact exchange@itam.mx and provide an updated academic transcript and a school letter indicating that you are a registered full-time student. Admissions will depend upon availability.

# **GRADING**

We recommend Exchange Students to take a minimum of **4 courses** per semester or trimester to maintain a full-time student status while at ITAM. Undergraduate courses are, on average, equivalent to 48 contact hours and 6 ITAM Credits. (Six ITAM credits are equivalent to 5-6 ECTS Credits or three US credits.).

All undergaruate courses are in person classes. You must have at least 80% in-person attendance in class to be eligible to take the final exam for the course.

Graduate Trimestral courses are, on average, equivalent to 33 contact hours and 4 ITAM credits. All courses are taught in Spanish.

Students must verify conversion-revalidation with their institution as well as courses revalidation.

The grading system is on a scale of 0-10, with 6 being the minimum passing grade.

A digital transcript will be sent to the home institution and the student, once the results for all courses have been reported.


