Enrolment Requirements	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A full-time enrolment is 32 credit points per semester – this is usually 4x 8 credit point subjects. • We recommend you select a minimum of 6 subjects per semester (8 recommended) in case of any changes to class scheduling prior to arrival. • All subjects must be available at your chosen campus. It is not possible to commute between campuses. • Check all selected subjects are offered on-campus (internal delivery); however a maximum of one 8 credit point subject may be studied online (external delivery) if it is not available internally on your selected campus.
Course Handbook	<p>The availability of individual disciplines is listed in the Charles Sturt Handbook.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Click on “<i>Advanced Search</i>” option under the search window • You can then search by course or subject area using keywords from your own discipline and course, • If searching by course, select the course from the results and then select “<i>Structure</i>” from the menu and click on “<i>Expand all</i>” option to see all subjects in that course. <p>Or</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If searching by subject, select a subject from the results to see more detail. <p>Contact csuglobal@csu.edu.au for a list of available subjects (classes) for each campus.</p>

<p>Application Process</p>	<p>Charles Sturt Global will work with you and your students to confirm the subject availability. Once 32 credits per session are confirmed, we will invite your student to commence their online application.</p> <p>Required application documents:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Passport copy • Home university official transcript (translated, if not in English) • Statement of Purpose • Proof of English language proficiency <p>Submit an application in Studylink for the following Course options*:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Exchange program (6 months) • Exchange program (12 months) • Study Abroad (6 months) • Study Abroad (12 months) <p>* Veterinary science students should contact csuglobal@csu.edu.au prior to application.</p>
<p>Tuition Fees</p>	<p>Exchange students – students nominated by their Home University for an exchange place receive a tuition fee waiver.</p> <p>Study Abroad students – current tuition fees can be found here.</p>
<p>Housing</p>	<p>Self-catered accommodation is available on campus. International students are guaranteed accommodation on campus if you apply by a certain deadline.</p> <p>Information on living on campus can be found here.</p>
<p>Meals</p>	<p>Enjoy our on-campus cafe and make use of the shared kitchen facilities in your accommodation to prepare your own meals.</p>
<p>Visa Information</p>	<p>International students must apply for an Australian Student Visa.</p> <p>We recommend you apply at least 8 weeks prior to travelling to Australia. Visa information can be found here.</p>



<p>Health Insurance</p>	<p>International students must have Australian Overseas Student Health Cover (OSHC) for the duration of their stay to meet Australian student visa requirements.</p> <p>Charles Sturt will arrange OSHC for exchange and study abroad students, with coverage starting from 2 weeks prior to the start of the session until 2 months after the end of your session.</p> <p>Information regarding OSHC can be found here.</p>
<p>Pre-Departure Information</p>	<p>Helpful information to assist you before arriving in Australia can be found here.</p>
<p>Airport Transfers</p>	<p>Free airport transfers (from our campus cities) will be arranged if you provide your arrival details – our International Student Support team will contact all new students to request flight details a few weeks before term starts.</p>
